Grand Canal of China

'a 2014 UNESCO World Heritage Site, including historic sites, locks, and other features'

✓ One of the oldest(6th to 7th centuries CE) and longest artificial waterways in the world (over 1,100 miles/ 1,800 kilometers), connecting Beijing in the north to Hangzhou in the south



✓ Purpose: to facilitate transportation of goods, primarily rice and other staple food crops, from the agriculturally rich regions of the Yangtze River to the imperial capital in the north.



It gained prominence during the First and Second Opium Wars in the mid-19th century when foreign powers sought access to Chinese trade routes.




Traditional Chinese architecture for a variety of shops selling traditional crafts, antiques, and souvenirs

Puyi's Former Residence: the last emperor of China












Mount Tai/Taishan



- One of the Five Great Mountains of China, holding great cultural and historical significance
- UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987 for its cultural and the natural environment
- A popular activity for visitors: watching the sunrise from the summit of Mount Tai is. The view is often spectacular and has cultural and spiritual significance.

DAY 7---DAY 8 Qufu: Hometown of Confucius





- Key virtues in Confucianism include **ren** (benevolence or humaneness), **yi** (righteousness), **li** (rituals and propriety), **zhi** (wisdom), and **xin** (integrity)
- Confucianism became a dominant philosophical and ethical system in China and East Asia, including education, government, family relationships, and rituals.




A Chinese novelist and poet best known for his classic work "Journey to the West" (also known as "Monkey" or "The Monkey King")







